The Construction Industry Ethics Course can help your employees navigate the ethical gray areas they face every day. It has been designed to help you understand ethics as it relates to the construction industry.

Effective January 2017, the Canadian Construction Association/BuildForce Ethics Course (both E-learning and classroom) has been mandated by Gold Seal as an education requirement for anyone taking their Gold Seal exam in April 2017 and beyond. However, ethics is an important company culture regardless of whether applying for Gold Seal.

The Classroom Component expounds upon the points raised in the e-learning component. It is an opportunity for:

- Collaborative learning
- Understanding how to think about ethics
- Incorporating ethics into the thought process involved in dealing with real-life scenarios
- Identifying issues that warrant examination through the lens of ethics

It is designed to illustrate the application of the principles conveyed in the Online Component through case studies, practical examples, and interactive learning through discussion. Registrants will have the opportunity to ask questions and interact with their colleagues and the instructor.

As a pre-requisite to taking the classroom course, you will need to have completed the E-Learning Course.
